I can print legibly, space letters, words, and sentences correctly.

Practice lower case letter "i" and remember to place the dot part above your mid-line.

Circle your 3 best "i's" with a green crayon.

Put letters in their place:

- Be sure your letter "i" starts at the top of the mid-line and goes to the bottom.
- Bump your lines!
- Letters don't have wings, so don't let them fly! You are in charge! Don't let lower case letters fly or get too big!
- Don't let lower case "i" take up too much space. Remind him that he stays in the bottom area (between mid and bottom line)
- Letters are like people living in houses. They live close together, but not on top of each other and you don't want them moving across the yard into the neighbor's house. Don't let the letters in one word bump into other words and keep them close together in their own "house".
