Put letters in their place:

- Be sure your letters start at the top and go to the bottom.
- Bump your lines!
- Letters don't have wings, so don't let them fly! You are in charge! Don't let lower case letters fly or get too big!
- Lower case "y" can get into trouble. He might try to leave his place below the bottom line. You must make him cooperate! He has a tail and the tail has to hang!
- Letters are like people living in houses. They live close together, but not on top of each other and you don't want them moving across the yard into the neighbor's house. Don't let the letters in one word bump into other words and keep them close together in their own "house".
