Remember to start with a "c" stroke first!

Circle your 3 best "d's" with a green crayon.

Put letters in their place:

- Be sure your letters start at the top and go to the bottom.
- Bump your lines!
- Letters don't have wings, so don't let them fly! You are in charge! Don't let lower case letters fly or get too big!
- Don't let lower case letters take up too much space. Remind letter "d" stay mostly in the bottom area (between mid and bottom line) but that part of it gets to be tall.
- Letters are like people living in houses. They live close together, but not on top of each other and you don't want them moving across the yard into the neighbor's house. Don't let the letters in one word bump into other words and keep them close together in their own "house".
